Workshop Sessions

Module 1

New Concepts in Tree Planting: This module will address planting procedures for bare-root, containerized and B&B stock from site preparation to guying and staking procedures. The discussion will include maintenance requirements for new transplants and troubleshooting planting related problems.

Module 2

Young Tree Management: This module will address key maintenance requirements for young trees with emphasis on structural pruning.
